Pike Place Market

Walk down Pike or Union, on either side of the Motif, until you run right into it!

Seattle Great Wheel, Aquarium, Ferries

From the Market, you can take the big stairway (or elevator) down to the Waterfront to find the Wheel (Pier 57) and the Aquarium (Pier 59). Find ferries to Bainbridge Island and other locations at Pier 52.

Space Needle, EMP, Chihuly Garden & Glass, Pacific Science Center

From Westlake Center (400 Pine), take the Monorail to Seattle Center.

LINK light rail's nearest station is about 2.5 blocks from the Motif (see map) and can take you south to Pioneer Square and the International District, or north to Capitol Hill and then the University of Washington.

Things to Know

Check-in, Registration, and Continental Breakfast will take place on the **THIRD FLOOR** every morning.
